CITY OF DAPHNE, ALABAMA ORDINANCE 2018-07

APPROPRIATION: INVASIVE SPECIES CONTROL FOR BAYFRONT AND VILLAGE POINT WETLAND AREAS

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2017-77 approved adopted the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget on October 2, 2017; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2018 budget, the City Council has determined that certain appropriations are required and should be approved and made a part of the Fiscal Year 2018 budget; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2012-48 sets forth an allocation of Lodging Tax proceeds that may be used for Bayfront grounds/property improvements; and

WHEREAS, the this invasive species control project meets such criteria; and

WHEREAS, the wetland areas at Bayfront and Village Point require additional invasive species control to maintain the wetland areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAPHNE, ALABAMA,, that

- 1. The Fiscal Year 2018 Budget is hereby amended to include an appropriation from the <u>Lodging Tax Fund</u> in the amount of <u>\$5,400</u> for Invasive Species Control Project: Village Point and BayFront wetlands.
- 2. The Mayor is authorized to execute all agreements, on behalf of the City of Daphne, as necessary for such purpose.
