CITY OF DAPHNE, ALABAMA ORDINANCE 2017-56

Appropriation for Fire Station #5: Architectural Design and Civil/Site Design

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2016-56 approved and adopted the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget on September 19, 2016; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2017 budget, the City Council has determined that certain appropriations are required and should be approved and made a part of the Fiscal Year 2017 budget; and

WHEREAS, the City is evaluating a parcel of real property upon which a future Fire Station/Public Safety Complex may be constructed to better serve the safety needs of the citizens of Daphne; and

WHEREAS, an offer has been made by the property owner to donate property located on Milton Jones Road and the proposed donation is currently being negotiated; and

WHEREAS, a new Fire Station facility will require architectural design and civil/site design services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAPHNE, ALABAMA that:

- 1. The Fiscal Year 2017 Budget is hereby amended to include an appropriation from the <u>General Fund</u> in the amount of <u>\$59,890</u> for the architectural design (\$34,500) and civil/site design (\$25,390) for Fire Station #5; and
- 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements associated with the project on behalf of the City of Daphne.
