

**CITY OF DAPHNE, ALABAMA  
ORDINANCE 2017-57  
MAIN STREET DRAINAGE STUDY FOR THE AREA: DAPHNE CIVIC  
CENTER TO YANCEY BRANCH**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2016-56 approved and adopted the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget on September 19, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2017 budget, the City Council has determined that certain appropriations are required and should be approved and made a part of the Fiscal Year 2017 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the Main Street area from the Daphne Civic Center to Yancey Branch on the East side of Main Street has had repetitive drainage issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the repair of this public infrastructure is necessary to preserve the health, safety, and convenience of the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined it to be in the best interest of the City to evaluate this project by requesting a drainage study of this area to evaluate the drainage issues and improvements needed; and

**WHEREAS**, this study would include a survey of the existing drainage structures along the east side of Main Street, modeling of the system and a drainage report detailing the findings.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAPHNE, ALABAMA that:**

1. The Fiscal Year 2017 Budget is hereby amended to include an appropriation from the General Fund in the amount of \$9,100 for the Main Street Drainage Study for the area from the Daphne Civic Center to Yancey Branch; and
2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements, on behalf of the City of Daphne, associated with the project.
