

Project Description: Attachment A

The City of Daphne Recycling Program is having growing pains. Residents have shown enthusiasm for recycling and are requesting that we accept more materials at curbside. Nearby schools have requested recycling containers and rural residents, eager to participate, need recycling trailers to be placed closer to their homes for easy access and convenience. The City of Daphne can not service rural homes with curbside recycling. We have an unmanned recycle station located at the Daphne Public Works facility that requires emptying three times per day due to overflow.

The City of Daphne Recycling Expansion Project Goals for the ADEM 2011-2012 grant are as follows:

- Increase recycling participation 35% by Daphne households and adjacent communities through development of one armed bandit curbside pilot program.
- Increase recycling tonnage by 25% through curbside collection and drop off facilities.
- Expand plastics collection to include plastics 3-7.
- Place 3 cubic yard recycling containers at every Daphne school to foster youth participation and awareness as well as increase tonnage.
- Increase visibility of recycling at municipal facilities through the purchase and addition of collection receptacles.

The City of Daphne proposes three layers to our recycling program. The first layer will develop a pilot program in our community to determine the suitability and efficiency of the one arm bandit collection trucks. The City of Daphne will monitor the servicing of approximately 1500 homes that will receive the new recycling carts requested in the grant. The City of Daphne believes the utilization of the recycling carts, instead of the bins currently used, will increase household participation and tonnage. The pilot program will include a feedback mechanism that will prove an increase of citizen participation. The use of this pilot program will dictate the development and future growth of Daphne's recycling program. Elected officials need evidence that the investment of this proposed expansion is justified and will accomplish said goals. This pilot project will also be utilized to leverage local leaders to mandate recycling for all Daphne households.

The second layer of the program is the development of two additional recycling drop-off locations. This grant will support the purchase of three recycling trailers and will benefit the people who reside in the rural areas of Daphne.

1. The Belforest Fire Department has agreed to allow the City of Daphne to setup a mobile recycling trailer on their premises for convenient access for the Belforest citizens.
2. The second trailer will be placed to serve the community of Spanish Fort and surrounding areas located prominently near the Eastern Shore Shopping Mall to serve those who do not have curbside recycling available.
3. The third trailer will be placed at the Public Works Department to handle the overflow from the unmanned station and will be mobilized for use at festivals, tournaments, football games, parades, and school recycling drives and competitions. It will also be used to rotate with the two new trailers so that an empty trailer will be onsite as a full trailer is moved and emptied.

In support of this grant application, the City of Daphne passed ordinance # 2011-11 on February 21, 2011 mandating that every department implement a recycling program. Recycling will now be expanded and enhanced at all of our city facilities. We have included collection receptacles for all municipal facilities to enhance visibility and encourage participation.

The third and final layer of the program is the school recycling expansion. We are collaborating with SEEDS (Supporting Education Enrichment in Daphne Schools), a non-profit organization sanctioned by the Baldwin County Board of Education, to introduce and supervise recycling programs in all Daphne schools. We will need to purchase (ten) three cubic yard recycling containers that will be placed at all Daphne schools. The two lip and latch kits included within this project will allow us to alter our current trucks to service these containers. To provide an additional incentive for school participation, the school's recycling materials will be weighed and the funds from the schools will be given to SEEDS to provide mini-grants to the schools. In addition to increasing school recycling tonnage, the City of Daphne will utilize the results of this study as a way to educate and encourage local businesses to participate in Daphne's recycling program. By being able to provide and combine these services, the City of Daphne will be able to give recycling new life and help residents and local businesses realize the immediate, long-term environmental benefits and economic savings attributed to recycling.

All layers of the proposed recycling expansion include a strong education and outreach component. The City of Daphne proposes to update our existing recycling brochure to advise residents of the changes in our program and foster enthusiasm. The *Auntie Litter* representative will conduct ten recycle presentations at our local schools. She will bring coloring books and other educational materials to help educate the youth of our community about the importance of recycling. We will also distribute brochures and recycled plastic water containers to keep the *Recycle Daphne* message visible. Lastly, the City has received letters of commitment from the Belforest Water Authority, Park City Water Authority, and Daphne Utilities to assist and encourage recycling by allowing recycling advertisements to be posted in their monthly billing systems.

The City of Daphne believes the approval of this grant is needed to help us achieve and surpass the recycling and solid waste minimization goals set forth in our approved solid waste management plan and the purpose and goals of the Solid Wastes and Recyclable Materials Management Act of 2008. This past year the City of Daphne recycled 2,959,912 pounds of material saving the City \$44,398.68 in landfill fees.

ORDINANCE 2011-11

MANDATORY RECYCLING ALL MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Daphne requires that each City of Daphne Municipal Building Directors put a recycling program together for their department with the assistance of the City of Daphne Solid Waste Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, diverting waste generated from residential and commercial facilities is essential to assist the efforts of our city's recycling program to maintain the State mandated waste diversion rate; and

WHEREAS, mandating the municipal facilities of the City of Daphne will help the City of Daphne exceed the State mandated waste diversion rate; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Daphne intends through this Ordinance to further the diversion goals through mandatory recycling for all municipal and city owned buildings; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Daphne intends to utilize its resources to stay in compliance with the State of Alabama 25% diversion rate and exceed our short term goal of 200 tons of recyclable materials per month.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on **March 1, 2011** after the date of its approval by the City Council of the City of Daphne and after publication as required by law.


WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Commission adopted the plan during its regular commission meeting on May 18, 2004; and




